Regular online stimulating workshops and webinars were conducted in the month of December, 2020.



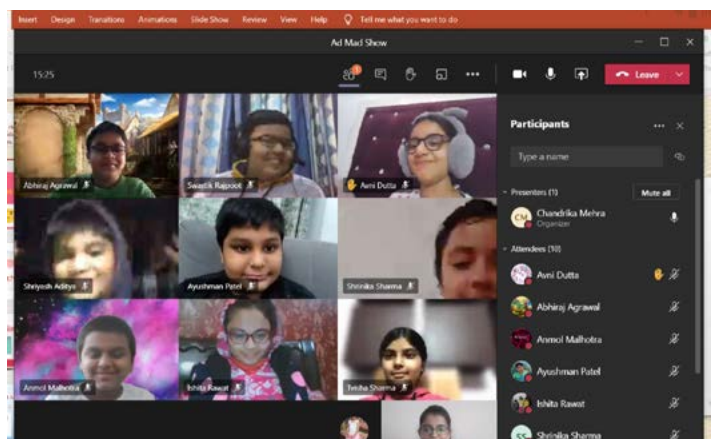
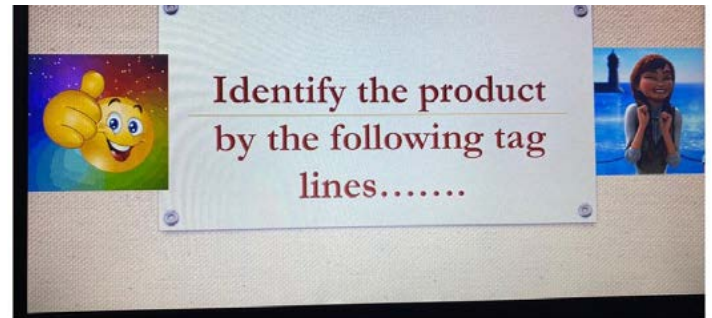

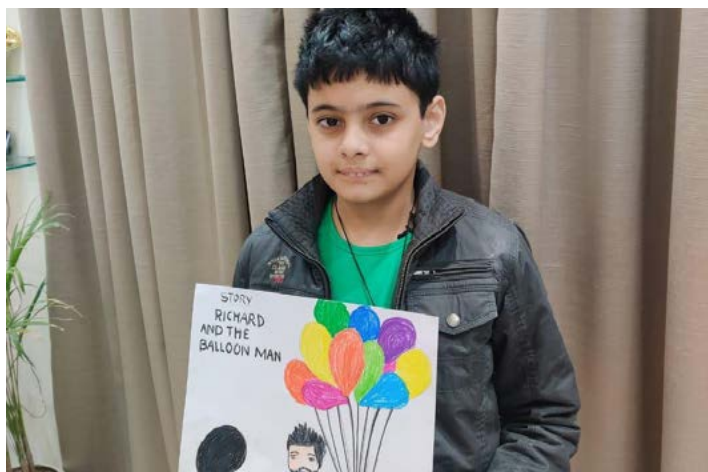


## KAL AAJ OR KAL (Activity)- Class IV
