## Kalam Science Innovator Awards 2020

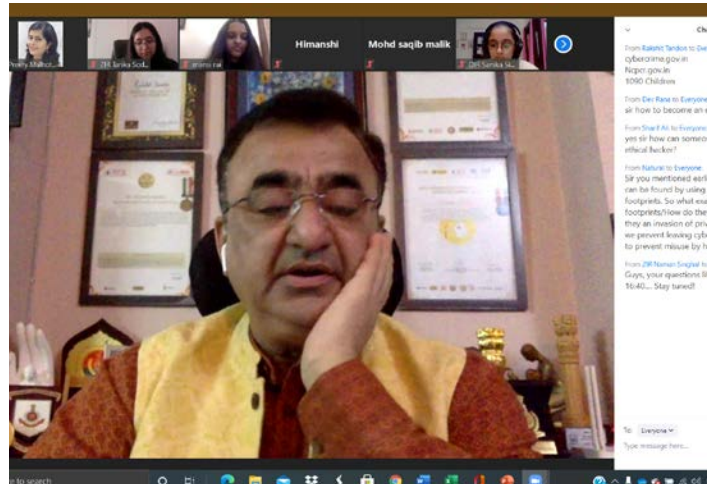

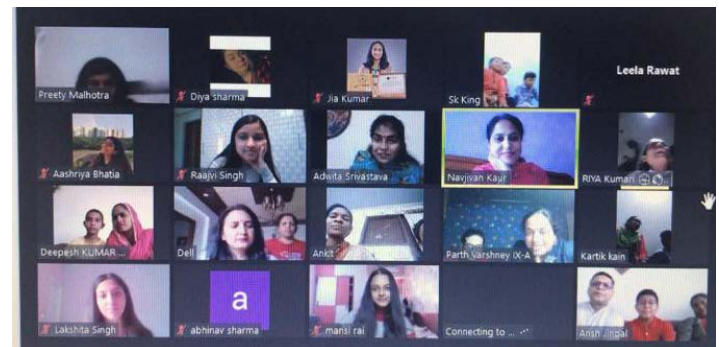




## Bring a Smile

Teachers, students, and parents of interactors along with several families of NGO attended this fun-filled session.



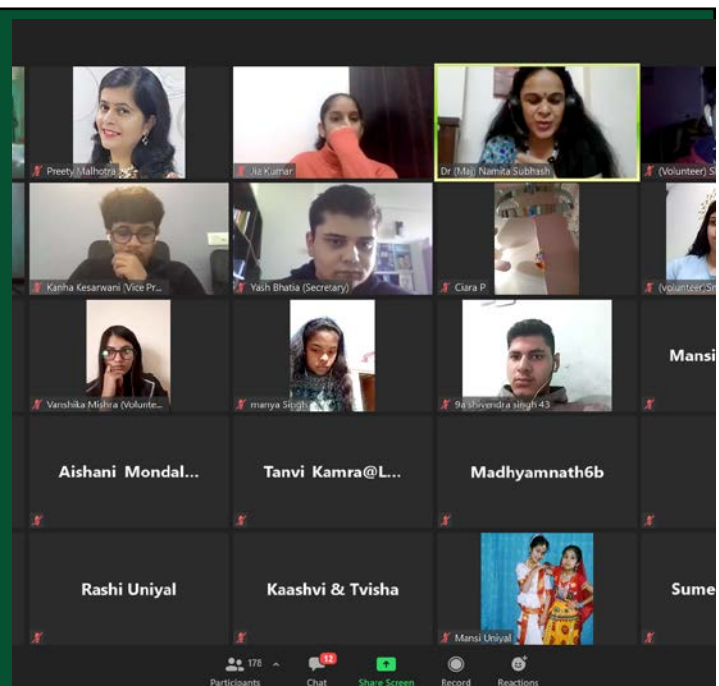
## Joy of Giving Week
