Achievements and Accolades

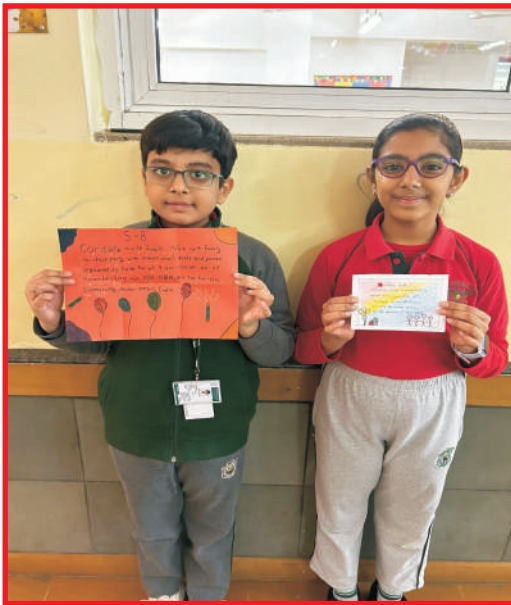

Subject Reports

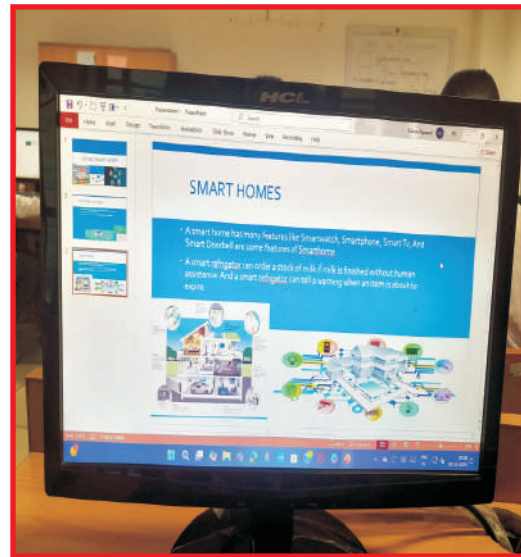
English

Computer

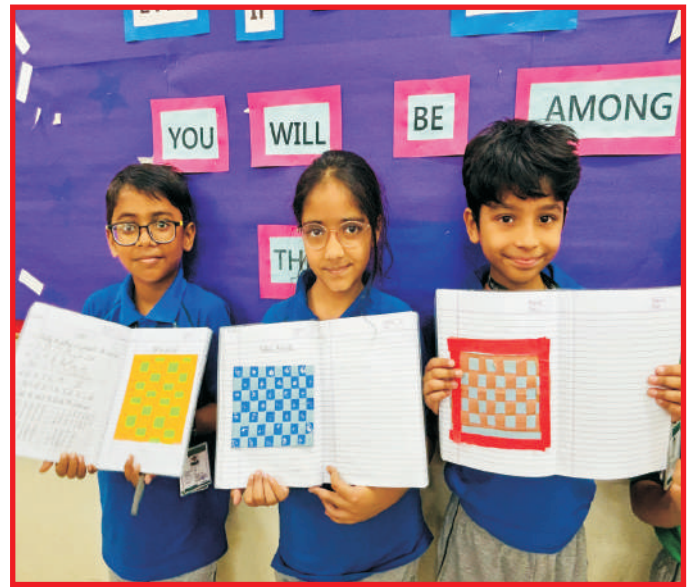

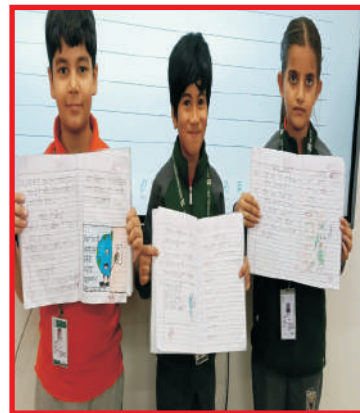
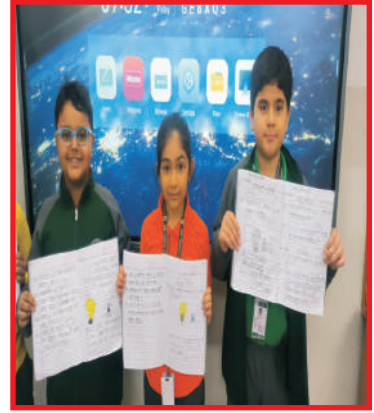
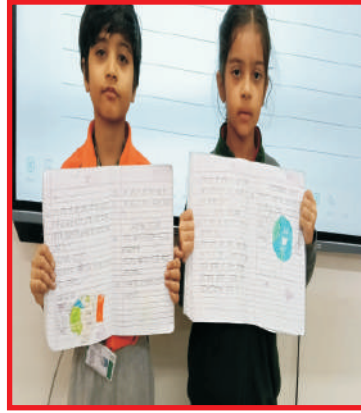
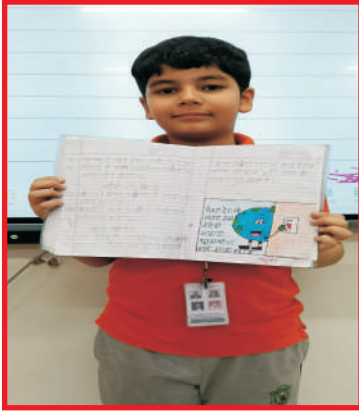


Hindi
