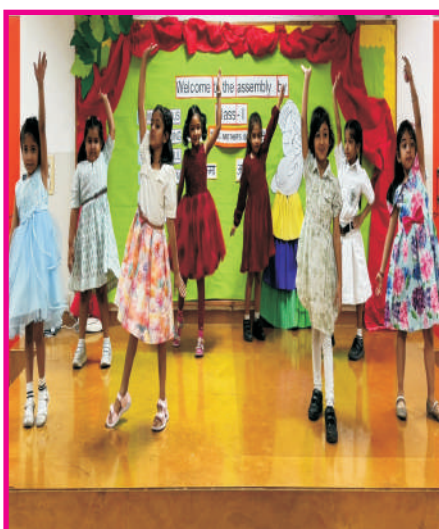


Mother's Day
