The Children's Day celebration was a resounding success, leaving Students with memories to cherish. We look forward to making this event even more exciting in the coming years.





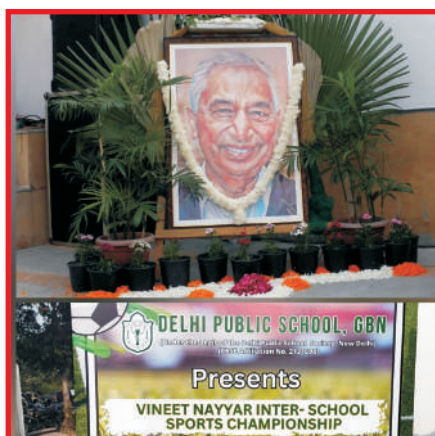
